## Step 1-2 · List your recurring tasks and estimate weekly time

List every recurring task. Think across communication, data entry, scheduling, tracking, and reporting. Be honest with the time.

**The Logging Test (Step 3):** Does this task require my professional judgment — or only my attention? Attention only = **L** (logging). Judgment = **LD** (leading).

## Step 4 · Calculate your logging load
